REFRESHMENTS: Sorry, these will not be available.

PRIZES: Cash prizes for 1st to 3rd in Competitions 1 - 4 & for 1st in Comp 10. Prizes will be presented at the end of the meeting. Winners must arrange to collect prizes as they will not be sent by post. Silver trophies and cups are confined to Norfolk residents for Comps 1-8.

If you won a trophy at the last Summer shoot, please return it to the trophies officer at the meeting for presentation this year. If there are any problems please contact the trophies officer (Chris Harrison) on 01603 742548

SHOOTING ARRANGEMENTS: The meeting will be squadded with squads commencing at 9.00am, 10.00am, 11.00am, 12.00 noon and 1.00pm. In each squad there will be two half hour details comprising 20 minutes shooting time and 10 minutes target change at your first distance, followed by a break, followed by two further half hour details at your second distance. Each squad will shoot two 50 metre and two 100 yard cards (80 shots in total); each target includes sighters. Cards will be distributed on the range. You must be ready to fix your targets TEN MINUTES before starting time. Competitors must supply their own bulldog clips. No ammunition will be on sale at the range.

CLASSIFICATION: Class A 97.0 and over Class B 95.75 to 96.9 inclusive

Class C 92.0 to 95.74 inclusive Class D under 92.0

AVERAGES: For classes B, C & D averages should be taken from the NCRA short range leagues, if possible, or calculated from the best 10 of your last 12 NSRA 20/25 yds cards. An average is not required for entry into Class A. Your average **must be certified by your club secretary or other club official** who should supply a contact telephone number. Failure to do this will ensure automatic entry into Class A.

RULES: N.S.R.A rules apply unless otherwise stated. Challenges must be made before the close of the meeting. The committee reserve the right to re-classify any competitor. When not in use, rifles must have a breech flag inserted or the bolt or action removed.

PERSONAL POSSESSIONS: N.C.R.A accepts no responsibility for any items lost, stolen or damaged on the range or its surroundings.

TIES: To ensure efficient scoring, ties will be resolved by the "count back" system.

All Norfolk resident competitors are automatically entered for the Norfolk Championships. The Gerald Farrow Memorial Cup will be awarded at the summer meeting for the aggregate of the Summer & previous Winter meetings and the winner shall be Norfolk's first choice representative at the NSRA Champion of Champions match at Bisley in August.

The competitor with the highest aggregate of the Summer & Winter meetings shall be deemed "County Champion" for the year.
