Competitors will be divided into classes according to averages.

Top junior placings will also be awarded in each competition.

The competition will be shot on electronic targets. Competitors are welcome to enter more than one event. Shooters of all abilities are very welcome to enter.

If you wish to shoot twice in the same event during the competition, please enter your second shoot under the 'Aggregate' competition. Scores from both your shoots will be added together and medals will be awarded to top aggregate scorers in each discipline.
